Education:



LEAK DETECTION DESTRUCTION

Saving water and resources since 1974.

Please tell your customers about the Meter Test:

Have your customer's had exceptionally high water bills lately? By performing the meter test, they can find out how much water they have lost to a leak. They can perform this test at their property without help from a leak specialist. The results should give them some idea of how big the leak is.

HOW TO TAKE THE METER TEST

- 1. Set aside 30 minutes to take the test. During this time no water should be used on your property.
- 2. Make a note of the current reading on your water meter. If you are having trouble finding your meter, most units are in the ground, in a box near the front of your house.
- 3. Come back in 30 minutes to check the meter. If the numbers are the same as they were when you started the test, you do not have a leak in the pressurized water system and you can stop the test here.
- 4. If the numbers did change, go inside and shut off the valves under all your property's toilets. Repeat the test.
- 5. If the numbers did not change after shutting off all the valves, it means the leak is coming from a toilet.
- 6. If the numbers changed even after turning off all the valves, you will need a professional leak inspection.

For an idea as to how big the leak is, subtract the numbers showing on the meter of the test from the number written down at the beginning. The result is the total number of gallons of water the leak is wasting! If your customer is losing a lot of water please refer them to us so we can help them pinpoint where that leak is coming from and get it fixed!

Legislative Update

SB 993 - Would require all businesses that do not meet certain exemptions to levy and pay a sales tax on their services. (Heard in Senate Governance and Finance Committee 5/16/18)

AB 1938 - Would prohibit an employer from inquiring about whether a job candidate has children. (In Assembly Labor and Employment Committee 3/8/18)

AB 2705 - Creates a 2 year statute of limitations for claims of non-payment of workers' compensation by contractors. (Approved by the Governor 9/10/18)

SB 1272 - Would help fight the underground economy. This hurts the pool industry by skirting the laws on taxes, workers' compensation, licensing and more, creating an unfair marketplace in which it is increasingly difficult to compete. (Enrolled and sent to the Governor 9/12/18)

SB 1343 - Would require an employer with 5 or more employees to provide sexual harassment training. (Enrolled and sent to the Governor 9/12/18)

Pentair Education Fund
