Founding Father of IPSSA, Retiring

Rick Kerchner of Precision Spa-n-Pool is one of 227 founding members left in what we know today as IPSSA. He became a member 25 years ago when IPSSA was formed in 1988 as a result of a merger between IPSA and Cal-IPSA.

In 1980, Rick was selling and installing spas. He had difficulty finding individuals to repair spas and decided to take the "bull by the horns" and teach himself how to repair spas; that led to repairing pool equipment as well. In 1985 Rick was contracted by Teledyne Laars to complete heater warranty work which led to a contract in 1992 with Jandy Industries for warranty work on all their pool equipment. One day while trading at General Pool Supply he learned of Cal-IPSA. He attended his first meeting (when it was held at General Pool Supply) and thought "this is a solid organization", so he joined. Rick remembers the meeting being extremely informative. When IPSA and Cal-IPSA merged and Capital Valley became a chapter, Rick decided to join. Rick is a charter member of the Capital Valley chapter. Ricks says "I stayed at Capital Valley because of friends and the many volunteers that run the organization".

Rick has been married to his lovely wife Sue for 36 years. When asked what he was planning on doing during his retirement he replied "Believe me I did not plan on retiring for a long time, but Parkinson's Disease has forced me to retire from the pool industry. It will not get in the way of enjoying my retirement with my wife. We plan on visiting our two sons in San Diego and our daughter and son-in-law in North Carolina more often. We are expectant grandparents with our first grandchild due in December. We plan on spending as much time as possible on the California coast. I would also like to restore old motorcycles and brew my own beer". Over the 25+ years that Rick has been in the pool & spa industry, he has built many relationships. "I am very grateful for the friends I've made in the pool business. The distributors in our area that I have patronized all these years have been so helpful by both the owners and their employees". Rick has learned much over the years and shares three things that have helped him be successful in this industry: "Always return phone calls. Remember you don't fix pool problems, you fix people's problems with their pools. Learn to listen and communicate". And finally, "Make sure the homeowner feels you care as much or more about their pool as they do".

Rick is a stand up guy. He is a gentleman and conscientious in his work. I am happy to have had the opportunity and pleasure to know Rick during our stint with sick route.

We are going to miss Rick at our Chapter meetings, and I am sure he will have a blast with his wife, children and his new grandbaby.


