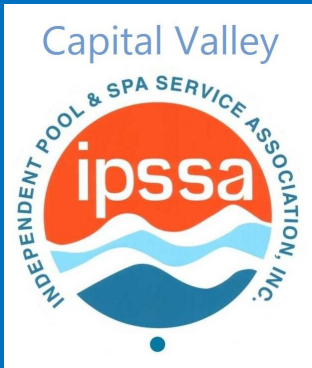

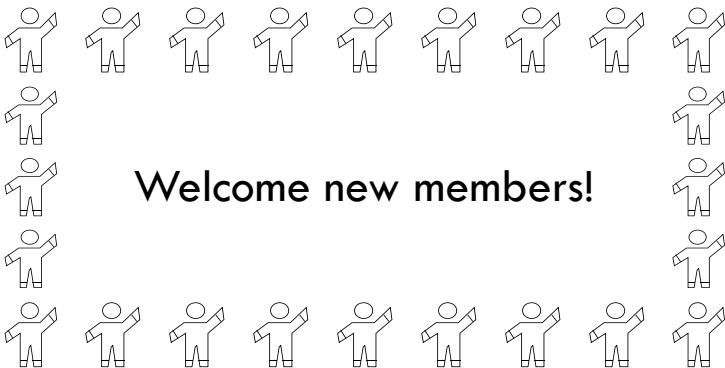

Controlling mosquitoes to protect you and your health.

Pool Program: Depressed housing markets and foreclosures have led to many neglected swimming pools in our area. Pools that are not maintained grow algae and bacteria and are fertile breeding grounds for mosquitoes. One neglected swimming pool can produce millions of mosquitoes and infect an entire neighborhood putting you and your family at risk for West Nile virus.

What should I do if someone I know has a neglected swimming pool?

Call us at 1-800-429-1022 or www.fightthebite.net to report the pool.

What can the local mosquito control district do?

- Work with a realtor, or property owner if necessary
- Place mosquito fish in the pool to eat the mosquito larvae
- Put a product in the pool that inhibits or kills the larvae
- Help you decide how to manage the pool so no more mosquitoes are produced

Please note that these actions stop mosquito production; however the pool water may remain dirty and dark until it is properly filtered and chemically maintained. During this time, it is very important to NOT add chlorine to the water because this kills the mosquito fish and allows mosquitoes to re-infest the pool.

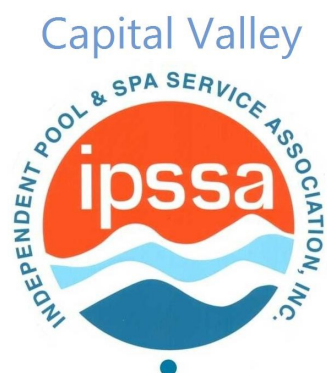
