A Message from Monte...

Why do pipes break underground?

Pipes installed in the ground would seem to be secure and safe from damage, but there are many factors that can damage lines underground. The main cause of broken PVC pipes underground is due to stress on the pipes. When a pipe moves or shifts underground, or was installed at an improper angle, it causes stress on the pipe fittings. While PVC pipe fittings are thick and strong, they can only handle so much tension and have a breaking point. A fitting will generally crack at the weakest point, either starting with a hairline crack or initially splitting open. The pipes themselves do not usually crack unless one end of the line has no where to move, if it is encased in concrete or gunite. Exterior damage to pipes is also a factor, including concrete stakes, fence posts, shovels, and tree roots. Homeowners should always be mindful when landscaping or doing construction over underground plumbing lines. The idea behind professional leak detection is to pinpoint the leak to avoid expensive excavation damage to access the leak.
